



Kindergarten Volunteers Needed

What an exciting time Kindergarten is for your child! I hope that your child is enjoying Kindergarten and sharing what he or she learned each day with you.

As the South Fayette Elementary PTA Volunteer Coordinator, I would like to take this opportunity to invite you to be a part of aiding the Kindergarten teaching staff and your child in a very tangible way. The Kindergarten students complete worksheet pages every day. To aid the teachers and students, I have two teams of Kindergarten parents who volunteer to tear these pages out and sort them in advance. With a team of 4 or 5 people, this task only takes about an hour. The work must be done at the school. You may bring younger children if you feel they are able to handle the school environment.

I try to have two teams, one comprised of volunteers with morning Kindergarten students, and one comprised of volunteers with afternoon Kindergarten students. The groups meet every other month. The AM group typically meets from 10:00 am until dismissal of morning Kindergarten. The PM group typically meets from 2:00 pm until school dismisses at 3:20 pm. The volunteers in each group will determine the day of the week that the group meets to sort the papers.
