Science Fair Project Guidelines

- Projects must be done primarily by the student(s); although, we understand that some guidance and direction by the parents is necessary. Group projects are permitted.
- Science display boards are not required, but are highly recommended and do make a nice presentation.
- Each student must write a sentence or paragraph explaining " *What I learned from doing my Science Project.*" This should be displayed with your project on a 3x5 index card or an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 sheet of paper.
