

## General Information

As a community service project, the PTA is scheduling drop offs of 6 dozen cookies two times a week at Meals on Wheels in Bridgeville. Meals on Wheels in Bridgeville is a nonprofit organization servicing the elderly in the community. They deliver a hot meal and a cold lunch to 60 people each day Monday thru Friday.

## Cookie Information

Each volunteer is requested to provide a total of 6 dozen cookies. They don't have to be individually wrapped. They could be put in a foil-lined box, a throw-away plastic container, or possibly zip lock bags if the cookies don't fall apart easily.

Please stay away from baking anything with nuts or seeds. It is OK to make peanut butter cookies. There is no one that has peanut allergies. There are some people with diverticulitis so that is why they ask for nothing with nuts or seeds. Other than that they will take anything. I've taken cookies, brownies, and slices of marble cake.

## Directions

The Meals on Wheels kitchen is in the Goodwill Manor building in Bridgeville. If you turn up Chartiers St. by Eckerd, you turn left at the third street which is Orchard Ave. You go to the end of the block to the stop sign. If you go straight you will go into the Goodwill Manor parking lot. I usually park by the striped awning and put my flashers on while I go in. You just go in the front door and go straight back, then turn to the right and go up the steps or the ramp. The kitchen is on the left. You can go there Monday thru Friday from 8 a.m. - noon.

## Other Information

Volunteers are asked to drop off cookies two times per year, however if you would only like to provide cookies once, that is great. Also some volunteers have requested to be scheduled up to four times. If you would like anything different that two times, just let me know.
